WHY CHOOSE US?

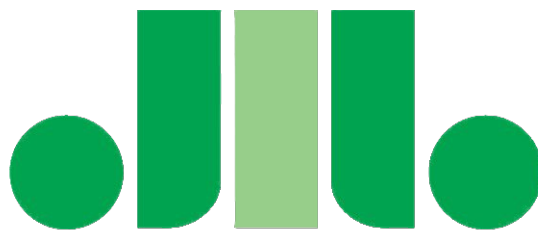
Playfords provides a multi-disciplinary and integrated approach to building services including, electrical, voice & data cabling and audio visual & IT networking.

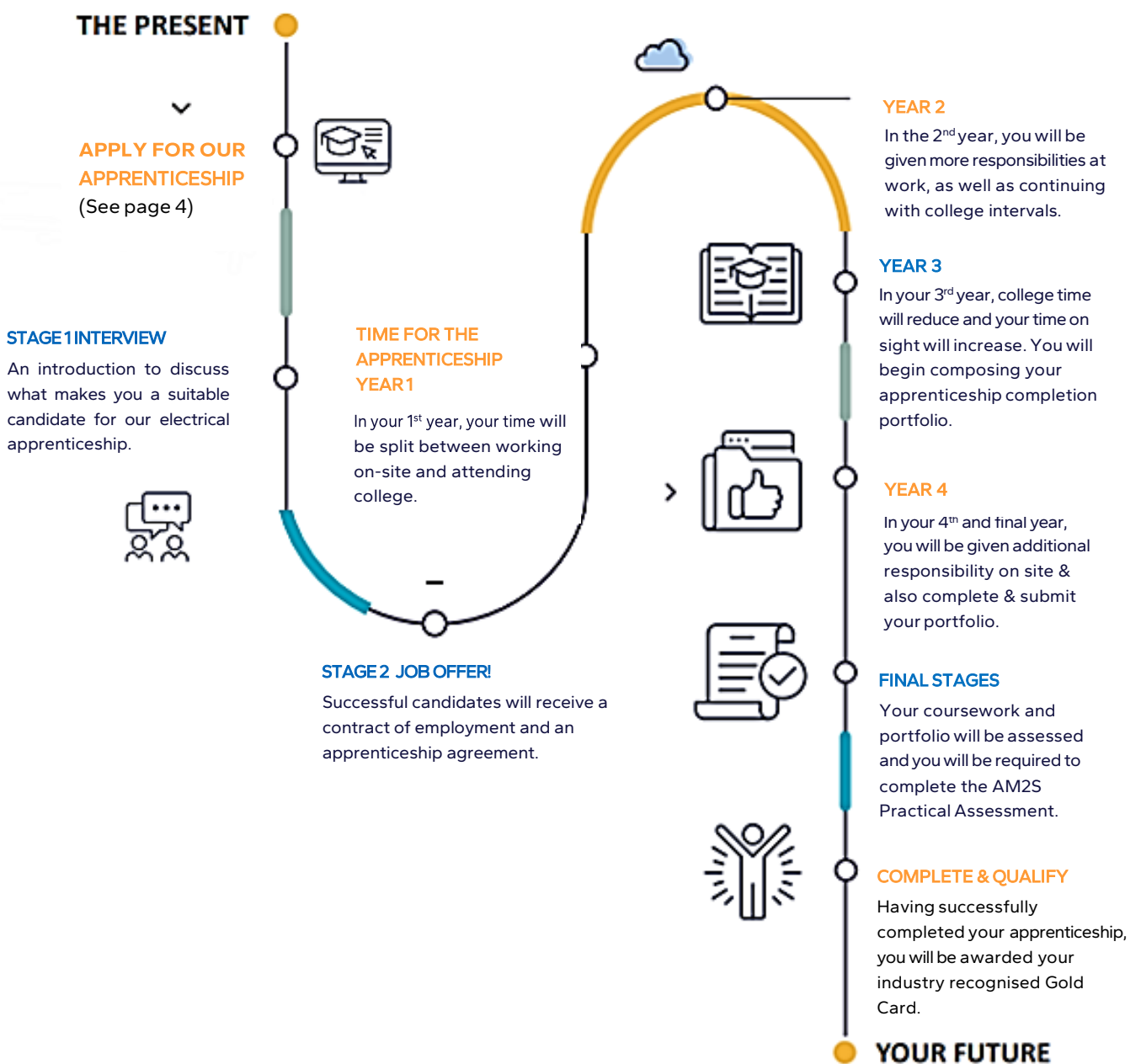

Our 4-year apprenticeship scheme to become an electrician is a combination of both college and on-site working, along with regular assessments.

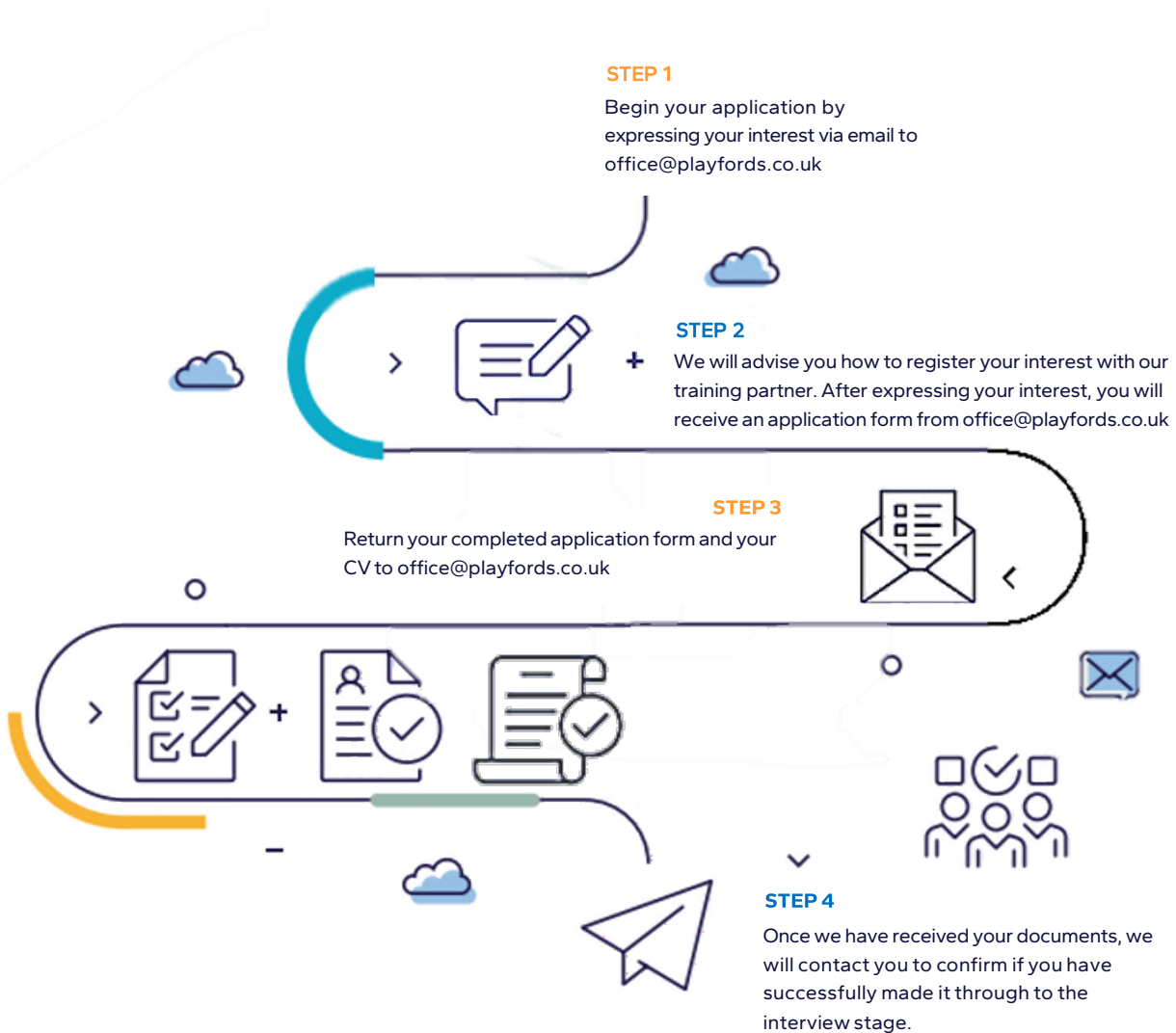

ANSWERING YOUR QUESTIONS:

1: WHAT GRADES DO I NEED TO OBTAIN AT SCHOOL?

You must be aged 16 years old or above (as of August 31st) to complete an apprenticeship.

3: WHERE WILL I BE BASED?

You will be based on-site at various locations in the UK. Our office locations are Huntingdon (PE29 6EF – head office) and London (EC4A 3DQ).


4: DO I NEED TO DO ANYTHING ELSE?

You will need to meet all requirements set out by our training provider. You will be made aware of these requirements at the interview stage.
